**\*COVID-19 Refund Policy**

Should limitations prevent complete access to any ski resort in Summit County, the following refund policy will go into effect. Families may choose Option A OR Option B in the chart below. No refund for Work Deposit, as volunteer opportunities will continue to be available. If a family chooses option B, tuition credit will be applied to the following season (2021-2022) program fee, calculated as the percent of total dollar amount that has been paid on the date the policy goes into effect.

January 31	50%	60%
